


This is our customer. Color him brave!



This is our Marketing Specialist. Color his glasses rose.




This is one of our contract negotiators. Color his mask, gun and heart black.

This is a human type engineer. See if you can color some life into him.




This is a universal console operator. Color his eyes bloodshot.



These are some of our fabrication specialists alertly waiting for yet another MTDS system to roll down the assembly line. Color the cobwebs gray.




This is one of our engineering checkout specialists demonstrating how easy it is to remove a circuit card. Discolor his fingers.



This is the MTDS Program Office football team. Color them black & blue. Redden their faces. (They do not require further shellacking.)




This is our latest Program Manager. Color him fast.






This is our detection and tracking computer. Make it an off-color.


This is the general purpose symbol display programmer. Color the programmer ambidextrous.




This is the console to computer buffer. Color him busy.




This is our correlator. Color it dynamic.




This is the intercept vectoring & ground to air data link system. Color it reliable.
